Condition report : No repairs, no restorations. The fire-painted surface (covering most of the sculpture) is stable, in good condition and completely original. The unstable, 'cold' painted pigments (the lilac painted areas below chin and hands) have partly faded.

Composed of two separate parts. Often Han 'Ladies' of this type wear moustaches. Although generally used within certain circles, the term clearly can not be taken as correct.
